 - a) A new pump has been installed in the well. Initial testing indicated the pressure is insufficient to run the irrigation optimally without supplementing with piped in water from San Jose Water Co. The storage tanks and pump will be installed in two phases after excavation for tank installation.
 - b) The excess dirt from interments has been removed. The vendor removing the dirt will excavate where the water storage tanks are to be installed.
 - c) The annual Financial Audit has been completed. Staff will meet with the auditor tomorrow to review the audit. Auditor will present the audit to the Board at the November Board meeting.
